## ✠ SEVENTH SUNDAY OF EASTER ✠ May 20 & 21, 2023

**"WELCOME TO WORSHIP!** After all, this is our Father's house where we meet together. He Himself invites us to listen to Him, to cast our sins, our sorrows, our anxiety on Him; He sets us free, and enables us to live as His children. O magnify the name of the Lord, for He is greatly to be praised!

**NOTE:** As our bell rings five minutes prior to our service, we gather in preparation for worship.

**HOLY COMMUNION:** "Our congregation, a member of the Lutheran Church Missouri Synod, celebrates Holy Communion (the Lord's Supper) with the belief and joyful confidence that in this Sacrament, our Lord gives not only bread and wine but, in a miraculous way, His very body and blood, once given and shed for us upon the cross. Faithful reception of Christ's gifts brings the forgiveness of our sins and the strengthening of our faith in Christ, our Savior. We also believe that dining at the Table of the Lord is an expression of the unity of faith we share in Christ. We ordinarily receive at the Lord's Table those who have been instructed in these teachings, according to God's Word, and who have confessed their faith in them. The pastor would welcome you to speak with him or an elder if you are uncertain if you should come to the Lord's Supper at our congregation. Others are welcomed to come forward and receive a pastoral blessing at the time of communion (indicate by folded arms)."
