- 4. Do I intend, by the power of the Holy Spirit, to live a godly life? (Eph. 4: 1-3)
- 5. Do I believe Jesus' body and blood are received with the bread and wine in Holy Communion? (Matt. 26: 26-28; 1 Cor. 10:16, 11:27)
